Sec. 25.863

Flammable fluid fire protection.

If flammable fluids or vapors might be liberated by the leakage of fluid systems, there must be means to--

- (a) Prevent the ignition of those fluids or vapors by any other equipment; or
- (b) Control any fire resulting from that ignition.
