Proof of compliance.

(g) The requirements of this subpart associated with icing conditions apply only if the applicant is seeking certification for flight in icing conditions.

(1) Each requirement of this subpart, except Sec. Sec. 25.121(a), 25.123(c), 25.143(b)(1) and (b)(2), 25.149, 25.201(c)(2), 25.207(c) and (d), 25.239, and 25.251(b) through (e), must be met in icing conditions. Compliance must be shown using the ice accretions defined in appendix C, assuming normal operation of the airplane and its ice protection system in accordance with the operating limitations and operating procedures established by the applicant and provided in the Airplane Flight Manual.

(2) No changes in the load distribution limits of Sec. 25.23, the weight limits of Sec. 25.25 (except where limited by performance requirements of this subpart), and the center of gravity limits of Sec. 25.27, from those for non-icing conditions, are allowed for flight in icing conditions or with ice accretion.

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
